Adopt-A-School & Education Programing

Partnering with local organizations to help meet unfulfilled needs. Most needs fall within the four following areas:

- TIME Many schools are in need of volunteers to fill various roles from classroom helpers and reading companions to running partners for Girls on the Run.

We have several groups/clubs/programs that no longer have sustainable funding, which will significantly impact what they are able to do with students.

This is a huge ask, but we would love to be able to host home football games at West. Currently we only have one set of bleachers and we do not have enough seating for even freshmen level games let alone a varsity level event. We need at least two more sets of bleachers as well as a better fence/entrance area to control who comes into events for security purposes.

WAVE Robotics lost a sponsor this year and needs more funding to register for the two regional competitions. It costs \$12,000 to go. They are currently \$3,000 short.

Student Council is hosting the State Conference in April and is in need of money to be able to travel to Madison

Our XCEL Program is an alt-ed program for 9th and 10th graders that is self-funded. They do a lot of handson, project-based work and strive to build a community for students who traditionally have a difficult time transitioning to high school. They rely on their students to fundraise and can always use more funding for projects and trips.

We are no longer allowed to use budget money to pay for staff tshirts or food for staff. This means I am unable to provide snacks, coffee, lunch, etc. for staff meetings and professional development unless I am paying out of pocket. That is not feasible for 180 staff members.

We are also in need of staff t-shirts. Again, with the size of the staff it is difficult to pay for without using budget money because the cost is so high.
